How have they impacted on your life?</li> <li>• Write down three things you would do if a friend of yours was anxious about starting a new school.</li> <li>• Think about what worries you have about going to secondary school. Consider some situations that you think might happen and that you are worried about e.g. you get lost, you forget your lunch...then think of some advice that you would give in these situations.
